

**Call for Papers—NEW 2011**  
**Abstract Submission Directions**

Your one page abstract should contain:

- Full name, address, position and contact information for all authors
  - Indicate name of presenting author
- Title of presentation
- Key words (up to 5)
- Type of activity (classroom demo, laboratory, lecture, etc)
- Abstract of concepts or activities to be presented, including
  - Objective(s) of the presentation
  - Concepts and processes to be discussed
  - Classroom or laboratory activities involved
  - Comments on how participants could use this information in their teaching

Also include the following if your presentation is for a classroom activity or laboratory:

1. Grade level intended (e.g., college, technical school, secondary)
2. Time required for activity in the classroom
3. Degree to which this activity has been tested and shown to be effective

For accepted abstracts, reviewers will be asked to recommend where your abstract fits into the **Abstract Selection and Programming Criteria**, available by request from Stacey Huang, Paper Coordinator, [hexoseh@gmail.com](mailto:hexoseh@gmail.com).
